

**INSTRUCTIONS FOR ASSESSORS:**

- Referees should be graded as competent or not competent when assessed at their own level ie. State A referee – beginner referee who has completed Level 1 theory course,  
State AA referee – referee with some experience at lower levels,  
State AAA referee – experienced referee able to referee almost any game at state level  
National referee – very experienced referee with level 2 qualification. There are three levels within the grade: National A, National AA and National AAA.  
National A referees should be able to referee at National Beach Junior levels to U19 or any level of state game.  
National AA referees should be able to referee any National game to Australian Beach Volleyball Tour level.  
National AAA referees should be able to referee any game, including games in the qualifying stages of Australian-hosted FIVB World Tour Events.
- Referees refereeing at games above those expected of their normal level should be assessed at their level, not at the level expected of referees who would normally referee those games.
- Recommendation for upgrading to the next level can be made below. When making recommendation for upgrading, the referee should be refereeing games of a standard above their normal level.
