Course Products:

- **Referee Accreditation** – On completion of the course and associated exams you will have achieved a *State A Referee Accreditation*. On completion of 18 games (5 games as a first referee, 5 games as a second referee, 5 games as a scorer, and 3 games as a line judge.) you will receive your National Officiating Program Level 1 Qualification of *State AA Referee*.
- **Referee Registration** – once you have completed your exam and submitted all required forms you will be registered for 4 years under the National Officiating Program.
- **'The Rules'** – the official rule book including beach volleyball rules and other official documents, reference material and Handouts.
- **Assessors information sheet** – to progress to the State AA Level you will need one of those persons to sign off few of your games.
- **Refereeing opportunities** – this will give you a basic outline of competitions and programs you can be involved in to gain experience as a beach volleyball referee.
